

## Community Behavioral Health Center: *“A Model of More”*

More **Access**, more **SUD Services**, more **Medical Integration**, and more **Levels of Care for MassHealth Members**.

Beginning January 3, 2023, the **Aspire Health Alliance Community Behavioral Health Center (Aspire CBHC)** is open at **460 Quincy Avenue, Quincy, Massachusetts**.

### Aspire CBHC Services for MassHealth members include:

1. **Outpatient Services for Youth and Adults: Call (617) 847-1914.**
  - Routine and urgent Outpatient care, including Mental Health, Substance Use Disorder and Psychopharmacology care
  - Same day and next day services as indicated by treatment plan
  - Expanded hours, including evening and weekend access, open 8 am to 8 pm, Monday through Friday, and 9 am to 5 pm on Saturday and Sundays
  - Peer and Recovery Coaching services
  - Care coordination and Navigation working with other providers, including social services
  - Primary Care Medical Screening and Coordination with Primary Care providers
  - Culturally Competent delivery of services
2. **Adult and Youth Community-based Mobile Crisis Intervention (AMCI/YMCI): Call (617) 774-6036 or toll-free at (800) 528-4890.**
  - Services provided on-site at 460 Quincy Avenue or in the community in the home or other community-based locations.
  - AMCI - Adults, Mobile services for clients aged 21 and up
  - YMCI - Youth up to 21 years
3. **Adult Community Crisis Stabilization unit (Adult CCS): Call (617) 774-6036.**
  - Short-term stabilization services in a supportive, therapeutic environment, providing an alternative to inpatient hospitalization, in a home-like environment, with access to a team of professionals including psychiatry, nursing, mental health clinicians and mental health workers.
  - Eight bed unit providing home-like environment at 460 Quincy Avenue, Quincy
  - Ages 18 years and up
4. **Youth Community Crisis Stabilization unit (YCCS): Call (617) 774-6036.**
  - Referral relationship with The Italian Home, Jamaica Plain.
  - Two age groups - 5 to 12 years and 13 to 18 years.
  - Aspire CBHC will facilitate referral and transportation to Youth CCS.
